## **BSTD Training Award**

# Eligibility Criteria, Nomination and Selection Procedure to be considered for BSTD Training Award

### A. Eligibility Criteria

- 1. Must be a Trainer, working or worked with a reputed public or private training institution in Bangladesh.
- 2. Education should be at least Masters' Degree or equivalent.
- 3. Total service as faculty/trainer in training institution(s) for professionals at least 6 (six) years and for deputationists at least 5 (five) years.
- 4. Must have at least 5 (five) training/development related articles published in reputed journal(s) and at least one published book with ISBN/BSBN.

#### B. Criteria to be considered for Selecting the Awardee (100 marks)

- 1) Academic Degree(s)
- 2) Total length of services as faculty member/trainer in the training institution(s).
- 3) Number of training courses designed/developed.
- 4) Number of training courses organized.
- 5) Total number of sessions conducted.
- 6) Number of national/international seminars/workshops/conferences etc. organized.
- 7) Number of Research work on training/development conducted and published in a form of book.
- 8) Number of articles on training/development published in reputed journals.
- 9) Foreign training received.
- 10) Membership of national and international professional organizations.
- 11) Any other contributions related to training and development.

#### C. Nomination and Selection Procedure

- 1. Applications will be invited for the BSTD Training Award by publishing a notification in the national Newspaper(s) and letter to be sent to all Institutional members of BSTD.
- 2. (a) If the nominee is working with a training institution, he/she should apply through the head of his/her institution.
  - (b) If the nominee worked with a training institution, he/she should apply through the head of his/her last working institution or his/her application should be recommended by a Fellow/Life/General member of BSTD.
- 3. Nomination has to be on a set format supplied by BSTD. It has to be submitted to the Executive Officer, BSTD.
- 4. The Executive Committee of BSTD will form a Selection Committee for scrutiny, shortlisting, and recommendation for the award.
- 5. After scrutiny necessary documents of the shortlisted nominees will be collected by the Selection Committee.
- 6. The Executive Committee of BSTD will take the final decision on the award after receiving recommendation of the Selection Committee.
- 7. The award will be presented to the awardee by BSTD in an Award Giving Ceremony every year.
- 8. The award will consist of a certificate, a crest, and cash.
- 9. A recipient cannot be given an award twice.
